LOCK OUT-TAG OUT

The "Lock Out-Tag Out" procedure is used to positively ensure a piece of machinery will not energize during servicing or adjusting. It's a procedure used in many industries.

Machinery in today's modern workplace sometimes uses more than one energy source. The most common is electricity; however, hydraulics, compressed air, steam and other sources can provide sources of power. It is important that a trained individual in lock out tag out knows all the sources of energy to be de-energized. It is not enough to turn the switch off. Procedures must be followed to lock out all energy sources and then to reenergize them.

Train ND, powered by Williston State College, has a lock out tag out training class for individuals that need to become familiar with these important safety procedures.
